Members expressed their disappointment that there had been no contact from the County Council regarding the possible changes to the Llanfaethlu road layout if and when the new road to Wylfa Newydd arrives!

It was passed to give £100 towards the maintenance of the two Church Cemeteries. The official request for the extension of the Llanfaethlu church cemetery has gone to the County Council.
